#### General Plan Annual Progress Report

- Guidance: No standardized form or format
- Approach:
  - Element by element
  - Summarize amendments
  - Highlight 2020 achievements
- Submit to California Housing and Community Development (HCD) and California Office of Planning and Research (OPR)

# General Plan Annual Progress Report Highlights

- Three Amendments to the General Plan
- Land Use: Adeline Corridor Plan adoption
- Transportation: Berkeley Vision Zero Action Plan adoption
- Housing: Eviction protection to over 400 households
- **Disaster & Safety:** Three EOC activations
- Open Space & Rec: Capital improvements for recreational facilities
- Environmental Management: Gas ban and building electrification
- Economic Development: Two loan programs
- Preservation: City landmarking of four buildings
- Citizen Participation: Pivot to virtual meetings
