Determination by a majority vote of the legislative body that an emergency situation exists, as defined in Section 54956.5.



RECOMMENDATION

Grant excused absence to Vice Mayor Harrison pursuant to Charter Article V., Section 19, and consistent with the City's bereavement policy regarding death of a "close family member."

BACKGROUND

Vice Mayor Harrison's mother passed away late last week. Her passing occurred before the Clerk posted the May 31 Agenda. It is in the public interest to grant Vice Mayor Harrison an excused absence for the May 31 Council meeting, pursuant to the provisions of Charter Article V., Section 19 and the City's bereavement policy regarding death of a "close family member."

The relevant Charter section reads as follows:

"If the Mayor or any member of the Council is absent from one or more regular meetings of the Council during any calendar month, unless excused by the Council in order to attend to official business of the City, or unless excused by the Council as a result of their own illness or the illness or death of a "close family member" as defined in the City's bereavement policy from attending no more than two regular meetings in any calendar year, they shall be paid for each regular meeting attended during such months in an amount equal to the monthly remuneration divided by the number of regular meetings held during such month."
