- 1. Reduce occurrences of the "two-hour shuffle" to...
 - Reduce inconvenience and citations for local merchants/employees with limited commute choices
 - Reduce greenhouse gas emissions associated with this behavior
- 2. Increase parking availability on residential streets
- 3. Increase information about and/or facilitate access to alternatives to driving and parking
- 4. Improve customer service and technology related to City's parking program















Pre-Pandemic (2019)

Fall 2021

- Presented concept proposals for visitor paid parking that were largely abandoned after community opposition
- Developed new strategies from public feedback

Spring 2022

- Collected additional data for evaluation and to develop new proposals
- April 2022 community meetings to prioritize proposals for Council recommendation

New parking permits for local merchant employees


Community suggested alternative

- Create total of 220 new employee permits in RPP Areas A, D, and L
 - 25 in Area A
 - 100 in Area D
 - 95 in Area L

(Area B at permit capacity)


















Visitor paid parking pilot

Community modified alternative

- New visitor paid parking on 2700 Durant, Channing, and Haste & 2300-2400 Piedmont
- Demand-responsive pricing and 8-hour limit 8am-7pm; Area I RPP permits exempt
- New "pay-by-plate" pay stations















Southside/Telegraph

Garage parking for local merchants/ employees

 Encourage local merchants/ employees to park at Telegraph Channing Garage

Both Pilot Areas

Facilitate transit pass benefit for local employees

Community suggested alternative

 Engage merchant groups and employers to create pilot AC Transit EasyPass Programs
