Background on Doorway How it started

- In 2016, San Francisco launched a redesigned affordable housing application system with a new web portal called DAHLIA. 97 percent of San Francisco's affordable housing applications are now completed online
- Building on that success, Alameda Count set out to developed a companion housing portal based on the open-source code for DAHLIA, called Doorway
- The Board of Supervisors has invested over \$2.3M since 2018 in building a robust system that serves Alameda County residents and continues to refine and expand Doorway
- Today, Alameda County collaborates with an internal working group (made up of city housing staff partners) and a second group of key Bay Area jurisdictions (City of San Jose, San Mateo County, BAHFA) to improve the scope and quality of the platform

Background on Doorway

Why Have a Housing Portal?

Providing low-income people and property managers with one-stop shop access to apply for and manage waitlists for affordable housing.









Applicant-Focused: Experience and Accessibility






- Available at Housing.acgov.org
- Site is available on desktop and mobile
- Listings are shown clearly and concisely
- Simple click-through interface avoids errors and confusion

Applicant Portal (cont.) Increasing Access, Saving Time, Providing Transparency



- A centralized location is more transparent and accessible
- A common application saves time and complexity
- An online electronic application minimizes errors
- The online application saves user information for future applications (optional)
- Applicants can review the status of pending applications and lotteries

Partner Portal Creating Value for Developers and Property Managers



- Listing creation is streamlined and standardized
- Important parameters like
 AMI charts and unit
 preferences are programmed
 and stored in the portal for
 easy implementation across
 multiple properties
- Applications can be seamlessly sorted, ranked, and approved, expediting lease-up

Inclusionary Housing

Empowering Cities to easily regulate


- The housing portal is a good introduction to affordable housing for density bonus and Inclusionary Housing project developers who have little to no experience with affordable housing and their requirements.
- Alleviates concerns about developers conducting sufficient outreach and marketing
- Gives some reassurance to the public about the transparency of the process and equal access to these scarce resources
- Data from applications exposed a mismatch between applicant needs and the size of units being produced and has informed subsequent policy
