# SCHOLARSHIP SCHOLARSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

## REQUIREMENTS:

Recreation program scholarships are available to Berkeley residents of all ages experiencing hardship or without financial means. These scholarships cover 50% or 100% of the cost of recreation programs, including summer camps, afterschool programs, special events, and more. To be eligible, applicants must live in Berkeley and qualify as low-income.

## HOW IT WORKS:

Enrollment for programming will be based on first-come-first-served receipt of the INTEREST FORMS. Interest forms will go out in three (3) waves to create more equity and distribution of the various sessions. There may be limitations on the number of sessions per program type by participant which will be rolled out at a later date. The interest forms will be sent out for specific program areas before open registration. Most of the covered programs have a designated number of scholarship spots. The first wave of interest forms include Berkeley Day Camp, Echo Lake Camp, and Tuolumne Family Camp; the second wave for Fun Camps and in-house programs; and the third for Aquatics (swim lessons for adults and children) and participating Specialty Camps. Interest Forms require each participant's name and the first and second choices due to limited space.

The new automated application process will reduce the quantity of personal documents and emails that go back and forth during the Renewal and New Scholarship Application process.

Required Documents (The required documents to have ready in a file or photo):

The Completed 2024 Scholarship Application

Current proof of income for all members of the household over 18 years of age - please provide separate proof of income.

Current proof of residency.

Proof of Guardianship - Applicant must be either a parent or legal guardian of any child/children participating in programs.
