

AUTHORIZED CURB CLEARANCES:


- House move or heavy equipment move.
- Loading or unloading of construction materials during construction under an active building permit.
- Access to property for construction and/or demolition.
- Temporary use of curb area other than parting.
- Moving Vans

ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES

- Printed permit, plans and attachments, such as a date-stamped photo, must be on-site for towing enforcement.
- Call (510) 981-5900 (Berkeley Police Non-Emergency) to tow vehicles parked in permitted spaces.

RESTRICTIONS AND LIMITATIONS

- Only parking spaces contiguous to the property for which the permit is requised will be approved normally.
 Parking spaces in front of neighboring property may be granted after the applicant has contacted the neighbors in a manner acceptable to the City.
- Temporary No Parking permits are issued only for the spaces indicated in the application. Only one (1) Cab Card will be issued per space.
- Standard meter fees will apply at all metered spaces and time restricted zones.
- Temporary No Parting permits do not include Seburdays, Sundays, or city holidays unless approved by Public Works Engineering.
- No Parting signs must be posted at least 72 hours in advance of parking restrictions.
- Permits do not override street sweeping restrictions.
- Temporary No Parking times may be subject to Preferential Parking Permit restrictions.
- Temporary No Parking permits will not be issued for parking convenience.

PUBLIC WORKS REQUIREMENTS

- A Temporary Right-Of-Way Use Permit and approval from a Public Works Traffic Engineer is required for extensive use of the public right-of-way, including staging or storage of materials.
- Approval from the City of Berkeley's Traffic Engineer is required for the following No Parking requests:
 - Posted restricted parting zones
 - 2. Blue, white and red curb zones
 - 3. Tow Away and No Parting zones
 - 4. Bus and Taxi zones
 - All driveways
