

- Adopted a budget with significant infrastructure investments

- Revised \$300M General Obligation Bond Resolution, added Ballot Question and Tax Rate Statement
- Revised Parcel Tax Resolution and Ordinance, added Ballot Question
- Further revisions to Vision 2050 Program Plan per Council direction and discussion

 - Option #2: split rate with stand-alone parking parcels covered
 - \$0.26787 for residential, \$0.40504 for non-residential
 - Flat rate on stand-alone parking parcels: choose either \$1,344 (median) or \$3,144 (mean)
 - No, or
