





Measure O Affordable Housing Bond: Impact and Updates






OVERVIEW

Measure O Bond

\$135M for Affordable Housing

- To increase the supply of affordable housing in Berkeley
- Passed with 77% vote in 2018
- Two issuance in 2020 and 2022, totaling \$78M
- Estimated issuances for remaining funds in 2025 and 2027
- Oversight by the Housing Advisory Commission



ALLOCATIONS

How is Berkeley spending its Measure O funds?

- \$39.4M allocated to completed and active projects
- \$53.2M for pipeline projects
- \$40M set-aside for BART sites


PROJECT SPOTLIGHT Berkeley Way

Three Projects Under One Roof:

- BRIDGE Berkeley Way 89 apartments
- BFHP Hope Center PSH 53 apartments
- BFHP Hope Center 44 shelter beds

Project Info:

- Developed by BRIDGE Housing and Berkeley Food and Housing Project on City-owned land
- 16 apartments are reserved for formerly homeless residents in need of mental health services
- 12 shelter beds reserved for veterans
- Community dining room at the Hope Center serves residents and unhoused neighbors
- City investment = \$27,467,062, including \$13,820,432 in Measure O

PROJECT SPOTLIGHT Jordan Court

Partnership with the Faith Community

Developed by Satellite Affordable Housing Associates on land owned by All Souls Episcopal Parish

Project Info:

- 35 apartments for low-income seniors
- 12 apartments reserved for formerly homeless households in need of mental health services
- City investment = \$6,026,927, including \$3,501,884 in Measure O




Building on the City's Investment



Renderings of two Measure O-funded projects currently under construction: Maudelle Miller Shirek Community (left) and Blake Apartments (right)



- The City is typically the first lender to award funds to a project.
- For every \$1 of City investment, project sponsors secure an average of \$4.60, maximizing the City's impact.



PIPELINE IMPACTS Growing Berkeley's Affordable Housing Portfolio

- With Measure O, the City is able to support new affordable housing developments on a much more significant scale.
- HTF inventory in 2010 = 1,134 units
- HTF inventory including pipeline = 2,124 units
