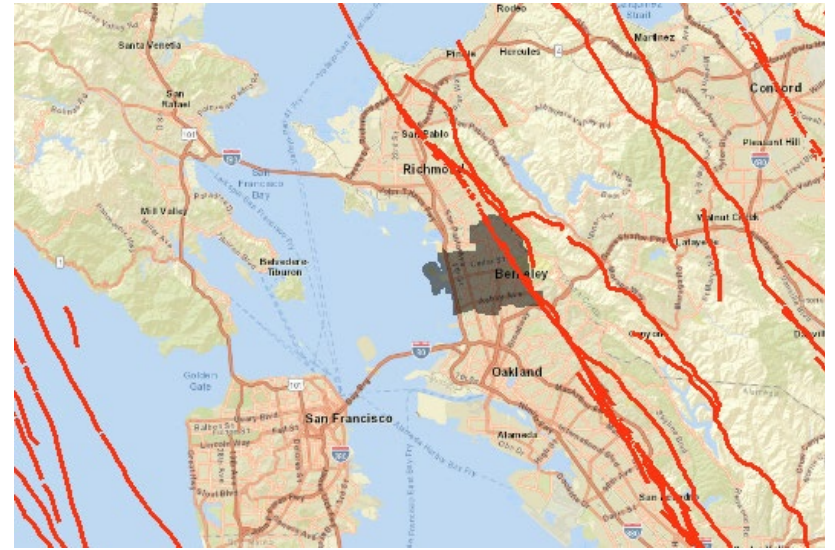
- Appendix to City's General Plan

# Planning Commission Update Role

- January through October, 2019
- Host public meetings (as well as the Disaster and Fire Safety Commission)
- Review content
  - Consistency with the General Plan
  - Specific review of land use planning actions in Mitigation Strategy
- Recommend adoption of Plan update by Council
  - First Public Hearing

# Readiness = Mitigation + Preparedness

- Mitigation: Reduce or eliminate disaster impacts
- Preparedness: Increase emergency response capability



# Readiness = Mitigation + Preparedness

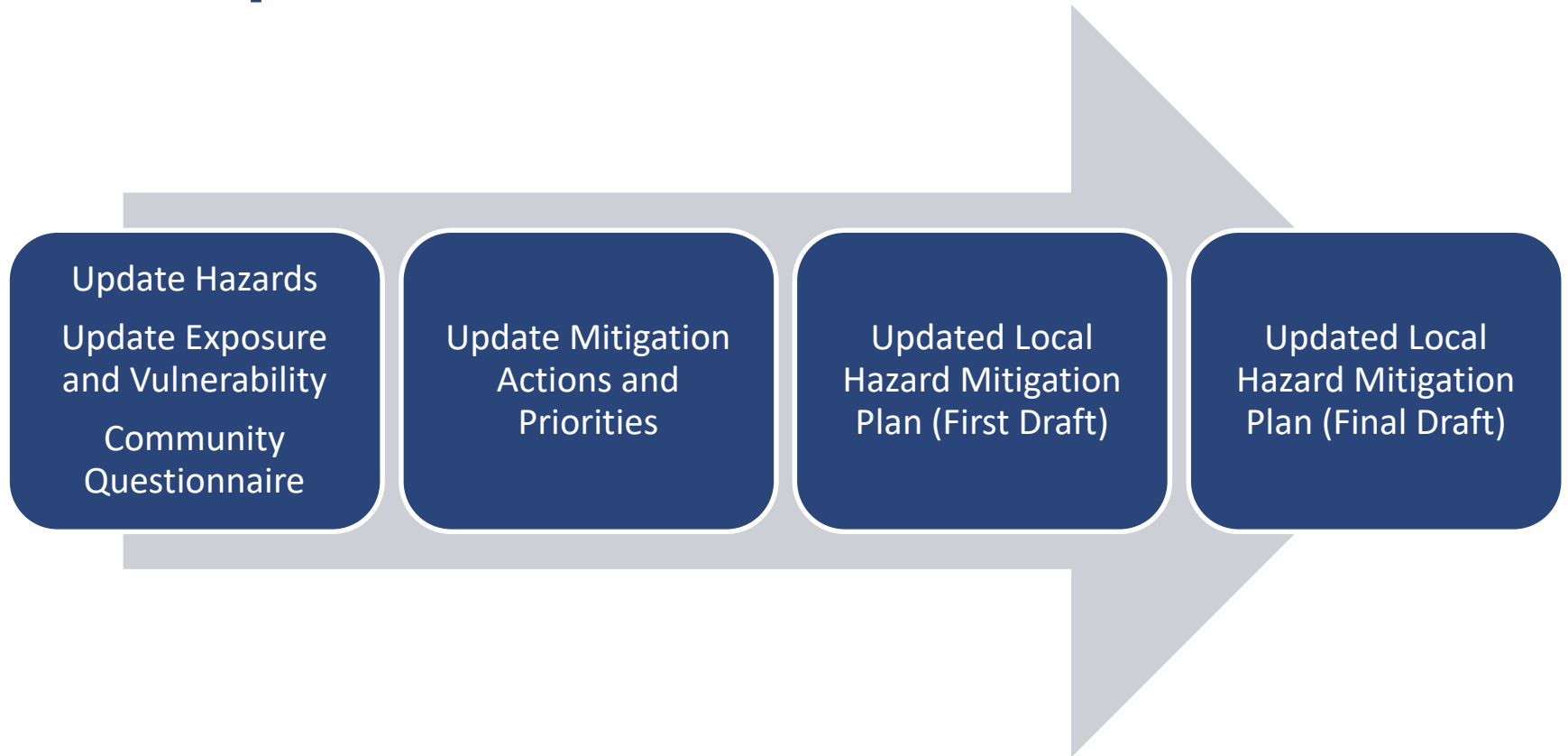
## Mitigation:

- Strengthening structures
- Making land use decisions that will minimize damage
- Reducing vegetation in high-fire areas
- Strapping down water heaters

## Preparedness:

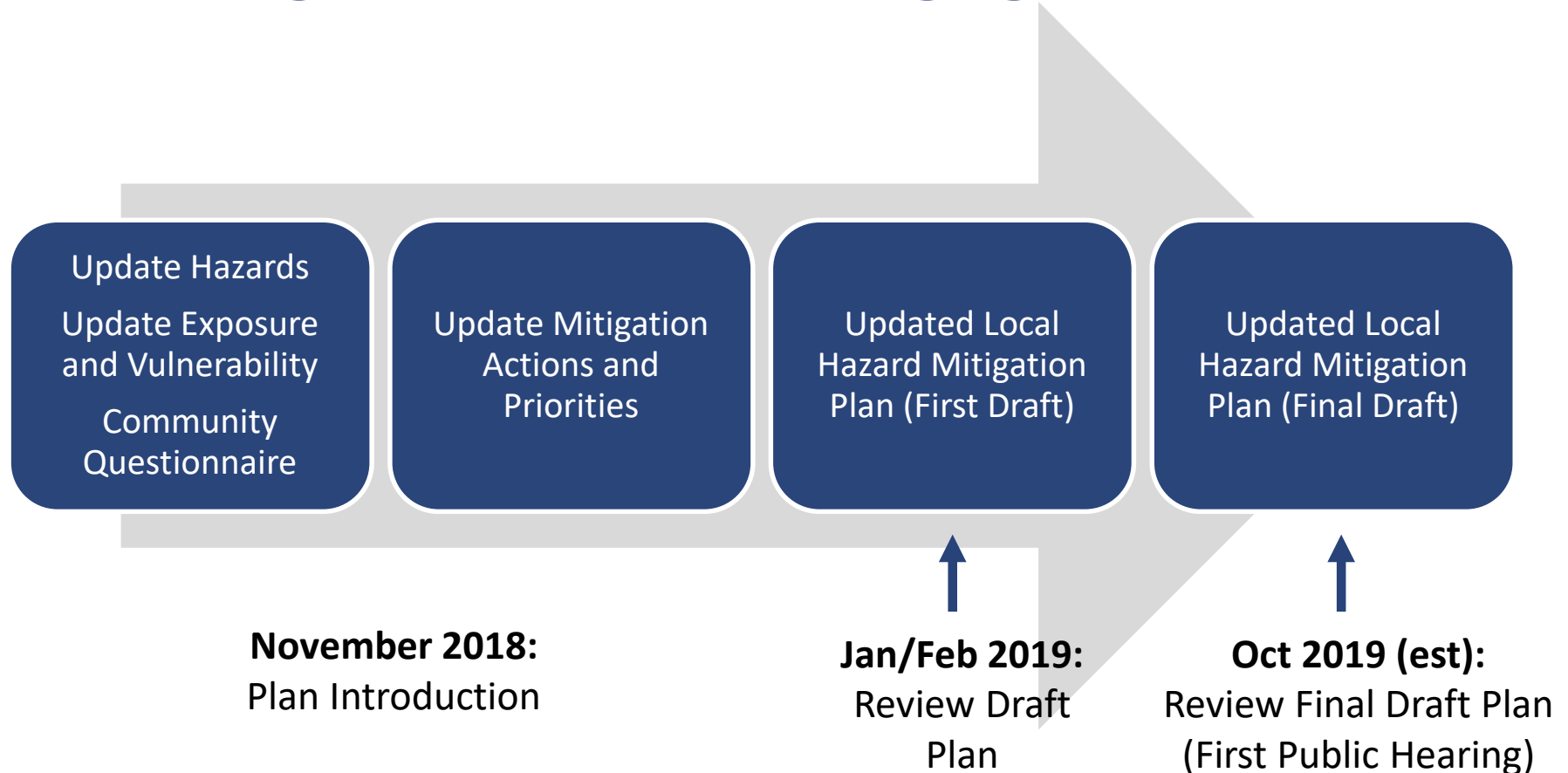
- Purchasing equipment to use in emergency response
- Conducting disaster response drills
- Storage of disaster supplies
