Background

Background March 2020 Referral – Amend R&D Definition

Existing Definition

A Research and Development facility is an establishment comprised of laboratory or other non-office space, which is engaged in one or more of the following activities: industrial, biological or scientific research; product design; development and testing; and limited manufacturing necessary for the production of prototypes.

Referral Requests:

- Remove prohibition on office space
- Allow for technological research

Background R&D Referral Timeline





June 2 Proposed R&D Definition

An establishment engaged in the following activities:

- Industrial, biological or scientific research; and
- product or process design, development, prototyping and testing.

This may include labs, offices, warehousing, and light manufacturing functions as part of the overall Research and Development use.

- Defined activities required for R&D
- Removed prohibition on office
- Addressed concerns about software firms
- Maintained protected space provisions in the West Berkeley Plan

An establishment engaged in the following activities:

This classification does not include computer software development firms.

Proposed Definition Defines Activities Required for R&D



Existing

is engaged in <u>one or</u> <u>more</u> of the following activities



R&D = research; <u>or</u> product design; <u>or</u> development and testing; <u>or</u> limited manufacturing

Proposed

is engaged in the following activities



- **R&D =** research <u>and</u>
 - design and
 - development and
 - prototyping and
 - testing



Existing Definition

- Requires a laboratory
- Prohibits office space

Proposed Definition

- Allows for office space
- Names ancillary uses (i.e. offices, labs, warehousing, etc.)

Ancillary: A use that is both dependent on and commonly associated with the principal permitted use of a lot and/or building and that does not result in different or greater impacts than the principal use. (BMC23F.04.010)

Proposed Definition Addresses Concerns About Software Firms



Existing Definition

Does not include "technological research" as an activity

Referral Request

• Lists "technological research" as an activity

Proposed Definition

- Does not include "technological research" as an activity
- Prohibits software development firms from being included in the land use classification

Proposed Definition Maintains Protected Space Regulations

The proposed definition does not change the following -

- Where R&D can locate (MM and MULI)
- Types of Protected Space that can be converted to R&D (Warehousing, Wholesale Trade)
- Conversion Permit Thresholds

Proposed R&D Definition Alternatives

Proposed Definition (staff report)

An establishment engaged in the following activities:

- Industrial, biological, or scientific research
- Product or process
 - Design
 - Development
 - Prototyping and
 - Testing

Alternative Definition

An establishment engaged in the following activities:

- Industrial, biological, or scientific research; and
- Product or process
 - Design;
 - Development;
 - Prototyping;and
 - Testing

This may include ancillary uses, such as labs, offices, warehousing, and light manufacturing functions as part of the Research and Development use.

This classification does not include computer software development firms.
