Subject: FY 2014 Annual Appropriations Ordinance

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt first reading of an Ordinance adopting the FY 2014 Annual Appropriations Ordinance (AAO) in the amount of \$364,296,041 (gross appropriations)* and \$313,633,047 (net appropriations)*.

FISCAL IMPACTS OF RECOMMENDATION

The FY 2014 Annual Appropriations Ordinance authorizes gross appropriations of \$364,296,041 and net appropriations of \$313,633,047. The General Fund (010) totals \$150,696,744 and the balance of \$213,599,297 represents the other non-discretionary funds.

BACKGROUND

The City Charter states that at the time of budget adoption that the Council passes an annual appropriations ordinance, which shall be based upon the budget submitted by the City Manager and as amended by the City Council. The AAO establishes the expenditure limits by fund for FY 2014. Exhibit A provides a Fund-by-Fund summary of these limits for FY 2014.

RATIONALE FOR RECOMMENDATION

The recommendation allows the City to set the adopted funding limits for FY 2014.
