BACKGROUND

I have attached the agendas to both meetings for your information. A summary of issues discussed follows:

Program Operations Committee Meeting

The agency is reaching out to childcare providers through BANANAS as part of their Public Awareness and Education program. They are continuing to do ongoing outreach

Administration and Finance Committee

The Federal “shut down” has impacted the program:

1. HUD grants cannot be processed
2. If the shutdown continues into December then the Lead Hazard Control Grant will also be impacted
3. EPA training has been stopped
4. Abatement companies need to register with the EPA...so that has stopped as well.

Finances of the program are on target. However, government shutdown may limit ability to receive grants from HUD in the future. This will be brought to the Committee’s attention if it becomes a problem.
