## IN HONOR OF DANIEL M. KAMMEN

- WHEREAS,** Daniel Kammen has taught at the University of California since 1998 and is the Class of 1935 Distinguished Professor of Energy at the University of California, Berkeley, with parallel appointments in the Energy Resources Group, the Goldman School of Public Policy, and the Department of Nuclear Engineering; and
- WHEREAS,** Dan was appointed the first Environment and Climate Partnership for the Americas (ECPA) Fellow by former Secretary of State Hillary R. Clinton in 2010, and continues to work in the State Department with current Secretary of State John Kerry; and
- WHEREAS,** Dan has contributed as coordinating lead author on reports for the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPPC) since 1999 and shared the 2007 Nobel Peace Prize with the IPPC, and he has served as the World Bank Group's Chief of Technical Specialist for Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency; and
- WHEREAS,** Dan Kammen is the founding director of the Renewable and Appropriate Energy Laboratory (RAEL), Co-Director of the Berkeley Institute of the Environment, and Director of the Transportation Sustainability Research Center; and
- WHEREAS,** Dan Kammen has taught with the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute at UC Berkeley to inform and engage older adults about energy challenges and solutions as well as climate change; and
- WHEREAS,** Dan has authored and co-authored 12 books and hundreds of journal publications, dozens of legislative and congressional briefings and reports, and served as a commentator in international news media outlets.1001011

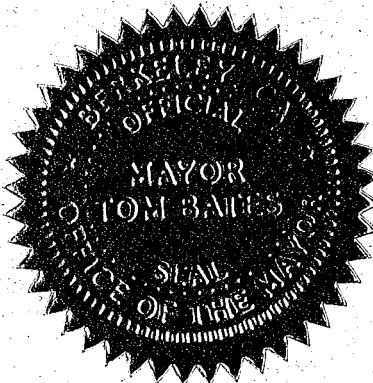
**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT I, Tom Bates, Mayor of the City of Berkeley, do hereby honor**
