

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
BERKELEY CITY COUNCIL**

**AUTHORIZE EXPANSION OF DOWNTOWN BERKELEY GOBERKELEY PROGRAM  
AREA**

Notice is hereby given by the City Council of the City of Berkeley that a public hearing will be conducted by said City Council of the City of Berkeley at which time and place all persons may attend and be heard upon the following:

The Department of Public Works is proposing to expand the geographic boundaries of the existing Downtown Berkeley goBerkeley Program area. This expansion would include the following blocks:

- 1700, 1800 University Avenue (Martin Luther King, Jr. Way to McGee Avenue)
- 1900, 2000 Grant Street (Berkeley Way to Addison Street)
- 2500, 2550, 2600 Shattuck Avenue (Dwight Way to Carleton Street)

The goBerkeley Program adjusts parking rates and time limits to achieve 65-85% parking occupancy at on-street metered areas and in off-street facilities. This target rate is equivalent to between 1-2 open parking spaces. Because parking demand varies in different areas, prices are set to different amounts in different zones within goBerkeley areas in order to achieve the target parking availability. The table below describes the current range of parking rates at meters within the goBerkeley program, per Ordinance 7498 (July 19, 2016). The table also shows the limitations on the size of rate adjustments and frequency of rate changes. Per existing program guidelines, parking rates may be adjusted by no more than \$0.50 per hour, not more often than once per 60 calendar days.

Notes: The goBerkeley meter hourly rate range will be adjusted incrementally, as follows: \$0.50/hr-\$5.00/hr effective FY 2017, \$0.50/hr-\$6.00/hr in FY 2018, \$0.50/hr-\$7.00/hr in FY 2019, and \$0.50/hr-\$8.00/hr in FY 2020.				

The hearing will be held on February 14, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, 2134 Martin Luther King, Jr. Way.


