RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution approving the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$250 per Councilmember including \$150 from Councilmember Cheryl Davila, to Consider The Homeless! (CTH), for their 3rd Anniversary, Matinee Movie and Fundraiser presenting the Berkeley Premiere of the film "QUEEN MIMI" on December 3, 2017, with funds relinquished to the City's General Fund for the purpose from the discretionary Council Office Budgets of Councilmember Davila and any other Councilmembers who would like to contribute.

BACKGROUND

We are proposing that the City Council make a minimum grant of \$50 to CTH, a group of Berkeley neighbors who voluntarily serve those who are living on the streets of our fair city. CTH serves delicious, nutritious homemade soup with fresh bread and distributes survival supplies that are donated, such as clothing, socks, blankets, shoes, etc. CTH visits the homeless communities throughout our fair City on Thursday and Sunday nights to bring for free hardy soup and bread that brings warmth a, leaves one's belly full and satisfied.
