RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution accepting a donation in the amount of \$62,154.42 from the Fusako Castro Estate to the Berkeley Police Department.

FISCAL IMPACTS OF RECOMMENDATION

The donation will be deposited into the Police Department's budget code 010-6901-368-2099. The funds will be used to support community engagement efforts. The donation will be appropriated as part of the First Amendment to the FY 2019 Annual Appropriations Ordinance.

CURRENT SITUATION AND ITS EFFECTS

Ms. Fusako Castro, a resident of Berkeley, California, passed away in May 2016 and named the Berkeley Police Department as one of the designated beneficiaries of her estate. It has been determined by the Executor of the estate that \$62,154.42 should be distributed to the Berkeley Police Department.

The City's Open Government Ordinance requires City Council disclosure and approval of any gift to the City in excess of \$1,000.00 (BMC Section 2.06.150, Ord. 7,166-N.S.).
