Item Description: City-Sponsored Emergency Preparedness Training and Emergency Preparedness Program

Recommend that the item be moved to Consent for the purpose of:

Referring to the City Manager to:

1. Consider increased training for City Employees and Councilmembers, based on what might be required of them in case of a major catastrophe;
2. Increase awareness among Staff, Councilmembers, and City Commissioners of voluntary opportunities to participate in training, and encourage such participation, with added emphasis on new Staff and Councilmembers at the time of onboarding;
3. Increase community outreach regarding training opportunities to better ensure that all citizens are aware of, and are encouraged to participate in, training opportunities and other emergency preparedness activities;
4. Integrate this referral into the City's existing prioritization of emergency preparedness measures, to ensure a strong and appropriately scaled training component.
