**Approval of Minutes:** M/S/C (Piercy, St. John) that the minutes of February 3, 2000, are approved as written. Absent: Alward, Freeman, Broderick

**Action:**

- 1. Approving steps for 20B utility undergrounding assessment district in Berkeley:** It was M/S/C (Piercy, Broderick) that the formation of 20 B district be encouraged with the City of Berkeley utilizing the 10 steps prepared by the Berkeley Task Force on Utilities Undergrounding; but that the Public Works Commission does not accept this as final approval of the process. Commissioner Perry expressed concern over going forward without more detailed cost analysis. Abstain: Perry; Absent: Freeman.
- 2. Bicycle Plan:** It was M/S/C (Piercy, Lofton) that the Transportation Commission forward to the Public Works Commission (and other impacted commissions) a final proposal for the "Bicycle Boulevard Design Tools and Guidelines" prior to taking a final action recommending issuance of a Negative Declaration to the City Council. After discussion, the original motion was withdrawn.

It was M/S/C (Piercy, Broderick) that the Public Works Commission support the "Bicycle Tools and Guidelines" as an advisory document, but not as a basis of policy. Absent: Freeman, Alward
