1. Timing of Expenditure of AB 2928 (Torlakson) Funds
Public works staff will present information about the possible use and timing of these funds.

C. DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. Berkeley's Street Paving Program
Staff will present information on the history of the street rehabilitation program, funding sources, budgeting and expenditures, analysis of pavement conditions, treatment options, ways to maximize investments in pavement rehabilitation, prioritization of paving projects, and impacts of the new "GASB" accounting standards. The commissions may later make joint recommendations on budgeting or other matters.
2. Street Maintenance
Staff will present information on current maintenance procedures, potential improvements to these, and related issues. The commissions may later make joint recommendations on budgeting or other matters.

3. Non-Pavement Traffic Facilities of Interest to Both Commissions

Discussion of other subjects of mutual interest such as signs and striping, traffic signals (including interconnections), and traffic circles, diverters, and other traffic control devices.

4. Coordination Between the Two Commissions

Discussion of the relation between the commissions, including the missions of each, impacts of decisions by each on the work of the other, and methods of timely communication and consultation.
