“Request the Public Works Commission establish priority streets for incoming Rule 20A money; that these priorities include major arterial streets that are to be used as evacuation routes in case of disaster and that they return with specific procedures in place for implementing the priority streets and there shall be a Rule 20A District moratorium until these priorities and procedures have been established.”
