**PROPOSAL**

The City has received a petition representing certain residents and merchants requesting daytime street sweeping of Claremont Avenue. As such, the normal requirements of the residential program would be in effect, including signage and parking enforcement.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

The Public Works Commission is holding this public hearing to receive any comments for or against the proposal. The meeting has been noticed by regular commission procedures, and in addition, notices have been distributed to property owners and current residents along the affected portion of Claremont Avenue and side streets. The Commission may or may not take action on this matter at its regular meeting immediately following the hearing.

The hearing will start promptly at 7:00 p.m. Those wishing to speak at the hearing must submit a speaker card at the start. The Commission may limit the number of speakers and the time granted to each speaker. A maximum of three minutes may be given to each speaker, but this may be reduced by the Commission based on the number of requests.
