**Berkeley, California (Thursday, December 13, 2007)** - City of Berkeley Police Department (BPD) Property Crimes detectives need the community's help to nab a burglar. Detectives have pursued the leads that they developed, but nothing has panned out.

On October 30, 2007 between 12:00 a.m. and 2:35 a.m., an apartment in the 2300 block of Webster Street in southeast Berkeley was burglarized. During the burglary, the suspect stole the resident's wallet and credit cards. At approximately, 2:44 a.m., the suspect attempted to use the victim's identification and credit card to withdraw cash at the Oaks Card Club in Emeryville.
