- \$1.1M Total Project, approximately \$750,000 for construction
- City of Berkeley Civic Arts and Friends of Ohlone Park

3. Summary of Previous Community Meetings and Engagements (Scott/Evelyn)

- 3 previous community meetings
 - First 2 in-person meetings in late 2019 to obtain feedback for determining location and ideas for types of improvements
 - Last meeting via Zoom in March 2021 to present park layout alternatives and concepts and obtain further feedback
 - In-person booth at the park in April 2021 to present alternatives and seek feedback
 - Presentation posted and comments accepted via email and phone.
- Future site improvements, not in current scope, but funded by Measure T1:
 - Lighting, \$700k
 - Restroom, \$500k
