

## **Coast Live Oak Pruning or Removal Exemption**

## For Coast Live Oak on private property

**Ordinance NO. 6,905-N.S.** places a moratorium on the removal of the coast live oak (Quercus agrifolia), and prohibits any pruning that is excessive and injurious to the tree. This is defined as the removal or more than one-fourth (25%) of the functioning leaf, stem, or root system of a tree in any 24-month period. This applies to single stem trees with a circumference of 18 inches (5.7" diameter) or multi-stem trees with a combined circumference of 26 inches (8.3" combined diameter) measured at 4 feet from grade.

Exceptions to this ordinance must be approved by the City Manager or their designee.
