Project Updates and Conceptual Design

- Ages 2-5 Playground
 - Nature Theme was the preferred option
 - Replace all equipment Play structure, swings, playhouse and benches, train engine, sand/water play, shade structures
 - Play surface Mix of sand and pour-in-place resilient rubberized surfacing

Ages 5-12 Playground

- Contemporary Theme and Nature Theme votes were tied so playground will incorporate pieces from both themes
- Replace most equipment Swings (included all access), climbing net with tree house and big slide, multi-person spinner, nature themed play structure, existing/relocated 'we saw', shade structures
- Play surface Mix of engineered wood fibar and pour-in-place resilient rubberized surfacing

Tennis Courts

- Adding courts infeasible due to cost, space and grading constraints
- Resurface with acrylic color
- Black mesh fencing
- Net improvements
- Shaded bleachers and benches
- Storage shed
- Drinking fountain

- Construction anticipated to begin in Spring 2020
