TIMBER PILE REPLACEMENT

Funded by: Measure T1, Marina Fund & Capital Improvement Fund

- Replacement of 66 timber piles in the inner harbor of the Marina that were either deteriorated or missing with new concrete piles

FINGER DOCK REPLACEMENT

Funded by: Marina Fund

- Over four phases, 66 finger docks have been replaced, the addition of floats on Docks D & E and 30 emergency ladders using \$1.168M of funding.

O & K DOCKS ELECTRICAL UPGRADE

Funded by: Marina Fund & Capital Improvement Fund

- Upgrade of electrical systems at K Dock – new switchboards, conduits, power centers, and power pedestals at slips
- O Dock upgrades expected to start in January 2024, including pedestals, power center and switchgears

UPCOMING PROJECTS

- **D & E Docks Replacement** – Replacement of dilapidated wooden docks & timber piles that pose safety & access issues, ADA improvements
- **Marina Channel Dredging** – Accumulated sediment at various locations will be dredged and transported to beneficial reuse sites
- **Pier Replacement with Water Transportation** – A City identified preferred plan for the replacement of the pier with recreation access and a new electric ferry
- **South Cove West Parking Lot** – Newly paved, fully ADA parking lot with new striping, sidewalks and crosswalks
- **Cesar Chavez Pathway** – 1.5 miles of freshly paved trail to increase ADA accessibility to the entirety of the Cesar Chavez park
