22 Pursuant to Civil Local Rules 6-2 and 7-12, the Plaintiff respectfully submits this
 23 stipulated request to reschedule the Settlement Conference set for Thursday, March 30, 2017 to
 24 Tuesday, March 28, or Wednesday, March 29.

25 **RECITALS**

26 1. On December 28, 2016 the Court set a Settlement Conference for Friday, March 3,
 27 2017. *See* ECF No. 38 at 1.
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1 2. To accommodate a senior Postal Service official who would like to attend the
2 Settlement Conference, the Plaintiff requested that the Settlement Conference be rescheduled to
3 Thursday, March 2, 2017, or another Thursday convenient for the Court, and Defendant
4 consented to that request. *See* ECF No. 40.

5 3. In response to the parties' stipulated request, the Court rescheduled the Settlement
6 Conference for March 30, 2017. *See* ECF No. 41.

7 4. On March 30, undersigned counsel for the Plaintiffs is scheduled to be in San
8 Antonio, Texas, to prepare for her April 2, 2017 wedding.¹ To allow undersigned counsel to
9 attend the Settlement Conference on behalf of Plaintiff, Plaintiff respectfully requests that the
10 Settlement Conference be rescheduled for March 28, 2017 or March 29, 2017.

11 5. Pursuant to prior stipulated requests by the parties, in addition to rescheduling the
12 Settlement Conference, the Court previously has extended the briefing schedule for the
13 Defendant's Motion to Dismiss in this matter, *see* ECF No. 15, and has continued the Case
14 Management Conference to coincide with the hearing on the Defendant's Motion to Dismiss, *see*
15 ECF No. 19.

16 6. The relief requested herein would affect the deadlines set forth in the
17 Notice of Settlement Conference and Settlement Conference Order, ECF No. 38, which requires
18 the parties to meet and confer 14 calendar days before the Settlement Conference; and to submit
19 Exchanged Settlement Conference Statements and Confidential Settlement Letters 10 calendar
20 days before the Settlement Conference. No other deadlines on the calendar for this matter would
21 be affected by the instant request.

22 **STIPULATION**

23 Pursuant to Local Rule 6-2, the parties hereby stipulate to request that the Settlement
24 Conference set for Thursday, March 30, 2017 be rescheduled to Tuesday, March 28 or
25 Wednesday, March 29.
