Executive Director's Monthly Report The Executive Director briefed the Board about: (1) HUD letter dated February 23, 2017 regarding use of net disposition proceeds; (2) status update of proposals/projects with the City of Berkeley, including (2.a) payment of \$10 per vouchers to BHA for a period of 3 years, (2.b) payment of \$50,000 for Damage Claim and Landlord Incentive Progrm, (2.c) Inclusionary Housing/Below Market Units, (2.d) City of Berkeley waiver of annual Rental Housing Safety Program fees for all S8 landlords, (2.e) Micro Housng Project, and (2.f) Gap funding for BHA from the City of Berkeley. Chairperson Norris added staff should coordinate with the City of Berkeley regarding passing of Measure U1 and see how BHA can market it to existing and potential Section 8 landlords. (3) chart about BHA HCV participant information; (4) BHA Dashboard report as of February 2017; and (4) selection of Renne Sloan Holtzman Sakai to be the lead labor negotiator firm for BHA in the upcoming contract negotiation with the bargaining units.

Finance Report-Period Ending January 31, 2017 Val Agostino, Chair, Finance Committee & Jesy Yturralde, Finance Manager Jesy Yturralde presented the Finance Report as of January 31, 2017 that reflected a slight reduction in the projected deficit for the fiscal year. Jesy briefed the Board about the analysis of the cash proceeds and operating shortfall based upon available information and the estimated timelines for how long proceeds would last.
