***Enchanted Seasons: Nga Trinh,
Heidi Rand, Shankar Ramamoorthy
& Larry Hatfield***

(Berkeley, CA — December 15, 2014) The Addison Street Windows Gallery proudly presents *Enchanted Seasons: Art* by Nga Trinh, Heidi Rand, Shankar Ramamoorthy, and Larry Hatfield, an art exhibition organized by curator, Demetri Broxton. *Enchanted Seasons* assembles the colorful, mixed media work by four artists who all belong to the El Cerrito Art Association. The Addison Street Windows Gallery is a project of the City of Berkeley, funded by the Berkeley Public Art Fund.

The artists featured in *Enchanted Seasons*, each explore one of the four seasons with their body of work. Nga Trinh captured the vibrancy of Spring through quilt-like, two-dimensional and three-dimensional assembled origami pieces made from recycled paper, such as floral calendars. Heidi Rand takes on Summer through both pigment ink prints and mixed media boxes and bowls. Shankar Ramamoorthy's work highlights Autumn through hand-printed screen prints of original photographs taken by him. Larry Hatfield tackles Winter through watercolors and a digital print.

Addison Street Windows Gallery

Background:

The Civic Arts Program, housed in the Office of Economic Development, promotes visual arts in the Berkeley community by exhibiting works of various artists. The Addison Street Windows Gallery (a.k.a. the Peter Babcock Memorial Windows) is a visual art exhibition space on the ground floor of the City-owned parking garage. Located in the Downtown Arts District, the Addison Street Window Gallery is a highly visual symbol of the Civic Arts Program.
