



SUBJECT: OBJECTS IN PARKS

PURPOSE

The purpose of this rule is to prevent damage to City parks, including the turf areas, preserve the aesthetics of City parks, and balance competing uses of City parks in a fair manner.

POLICY

PURSUANT TO BMC 6.32.030:

1. No person shall set up, place, or install any structure or large object(s) in the outdoor area of a City park without a City-issued permit. A structure or large object(s), as used in this Administrative Rule, is any object, or collection of objects, with a footprint or coverage area of 10 square feet or more, including but not limited to a tent or table exceeding that size. No person shall leave or store any unattended personal property in the outdoor area of a City park, regardless of the size. The City itself is exempt from this Rule.
2. Except pursuant to a written, City-issued lease or license agreement, no person shall place, store, collect, or work on, any bicycles or bicycle parts in any City park. This prohibition does not apply to any person who is temporarily storing (e.g., locked to a bike rack) or repairing (e.g., fixing a flat tire) a single bicycle that he or she or a family member uses for transportation or recreation.
