

Ballot Measure Re-Authorizing Expenditures of Voter-Approved Taxes for Parks Maintenance, Library Relief, Emergency Medical Services, Emergency Services for Severely Physically Disabled Persons and Fire Protection and Emergency Response and Preparedness, Under Article XIIB of the California Constitution (Gann Limit)

### **BALLOT QUESTION**

Shall the appropriation limit under Article XIIB of the California Constitution (which limits city expenditures) be increased to allow for the expenditure of taxes previously approved by the voters for parks maintenance; libraries; emergency medical services; emergency services for severely disabled persons; and fire protection and emergency response and preparedness, for fiscal years 2013 through 2016?

Financial Implications: This measure would not increase taxes. It only authorizes expenditure of existing voter-approved taxes.

### **FULL TEXT OF MEASURE\***

Shall the appropriation limit under Article XIIB of the California Constitution (which is a ceiling on city expenditures) be increased to allow for the expenditure of taxes previously approved by the voters for parks maintenance; libraries; emergency medical services; emergency services for severely disabled persons; and fire protection and emergency response and preparedness, for fiscal years 2013 through 2016?

Financial Implications: This measure would not increase taxes. It only authorizes expenditure of existing voter-approved taxes.
