This is the final response to your January 9, 2013, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) for the DNDO radiation fly-over from August 27, 2012 to September 1, 2012. This office received your request on January 9, 2013.

A search of the Domestic Nuclear Detection Office (DNDO) for documents responsive to your request produced a total of 48 pages.

We are granting your request under FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, and DHS' implementing regulations, 6 C.F.R. Part 5. After carefully reviewing the responsive document, I determined that it is appropriate for public release. The document is enclosed in its entirety; DHS has claimed no deletions or exemptions.

Provisions of FOIA allow us to recover part of the cost of complying with your request. In this instance, because the cost is below the \$14 minimum, there is no charge.
