Subject: Berkeley Project Day – Saturday, November 3, 2018

The next Berkeley Project Day (BP Day) is on Saturday, November 3, 2018. Approximately 600 UC Berkeley students will perform volunteer service at eighteen (18) project sites as provided below. The City of Berkeley provides funding for this BP Day through a community agency contract with the Associated Students of the University of California (ASUC). This year's day of service involves a partnership between UC Berkeley, the City of Berkeley, and local park stewardship volunteers.

1. **Aquatic Park Dreamland.** 15 students. Weeding and mulching butterfly garden.
2. **Aquatic Park.** 50 students. Litter pickup in the park, weeding and mulching.
3. **Berkeley Police Department.** 30 students. Litter pickup, raking up leaves, weeding planter beds and pruning shrubs.
4. **Berkeley Rose Garden.** 50 students. Removing ivy and old ground cover.
5. **Berkeley Waterfront.** 50 students. Weeding, litter, and general clean up.
6. **Cesar Chavez Park.** 30 students. Painting benches.
7. **Grove Park.** 25 students. Weeding beds.
8. **Halcyon Commons.** 20 students. Weeding, mulching, raking, sweeping and litter pick up.
9. **Indian Rock Park.** 30 students. Removing ivy, weeding, mulching, and raking up bark.
10. **Martin Luther King, Jr. Youth Services Center.** 25 students. Weeding, mulching, raking and sweeping behind the recreation building for the annual Haunted House. (This project is an ongoing site and most recently occurred on 10/20/2018).
11. **Median @ Adeline & Fairview.** 25 students. Weeding, raking, mulching, and sweeping.
12. **Median @ Short Street (North Berkeley BART).** 20 Students. Removing/grubbing ivy, mulching area.

13. **Ohlone Dog Park.** 25 students. Redistributing chips, removing vines from fence, weeding outside fence and sweeping.
14. **Ohlone Park Soccer Field.** 30 Students. Clearing vegetation from the west and north ends of the soccer field fence lines.
15. **San Pablo Park.** 50 students. Weeding and cleaning, sand boxes, removing nonessential turf around trees, and spreading mulch.
16. **Strawberry Creek Park.** 50 students. Weeding, raking, sweeping, sifting sand, litter pickup and general clean up.
17. **Stuart Street near Willard Park.** 30 Students. Gutter cleaning on the south side of campus.
18. **Tamalpais Steps.** 30 Students. Clearing pathway and steps of encroaching vegetation; staging vegetation.
