Dear Neighbor,

EBMUD is proposing to install four major transmission pipelines, one of which is located in the City of Berkeley. The pipeline in the City of Berkeley is a new 48-inch pipeline (Wildcat Aqueduct (Southern Portion)) which would provide needed additional water transmission capacity to customers from Berkeley to Pinole. The preferred pipeline alignment is approximately 8,200 feet long and connects to existing pipelines in Parkside Drive to Parker Street /Dana Street. An Environmental Impact Report will be prepared for the project commencing in December 2011 and is scheduled to be completed and approved in spring 2013. Construction of the pipeline is tentatively scheduled for 2015.

Please join us at the Willard Middle School on Wednesday, November 9, 2011 for a project meeting where EBMUD engineers will present the project and solicit public comment.
