Subject: OCTOBER 21, 2014 DISASTER PREPAREDNESS WORK SESSION

On October 21, 2014, at 5:30 p.m., a Council Work Session has been scheduled to provide information to the Council on the city's disaster preparedness and mitigation efforts since the 1989 Loma Prieta earthquake.

As part of the work session, fire department staff will provide refresher training on the role and responsibilities of the City Council or Standby Officers during a disaster. The Fire Chief and I will be sending letters to your Standby Officers inviting them to attend the work session.

The August 24th Napa earthquake serves as a great reminder on how a major earthquake can impact the community and the need for the City to stay active with its disaster mitigation and preparedness efforts.
