SUBJECT: Sugar-Sweetened Beverage Tax Revenues

As you know, Berkeley voters in November 2014 passed Measure D, a tax on sugar-sweetened beverages. The first month of tax implementation was in March 2015, for which taxes were to be paid to the City in May. The revenues for the past year, including the most recent three months, are below:
