SUBJECT: Sugar Sweetened Beverage Tax Revenues

As you know, in November 2014, Berkeley voters passed Measure D tax on sugar-sweetened beverages. The first month of tax implementation was in March 2015. Revenues for the most recent five months are below. Please note, the City increased outreach to self-distributors in 2016, leading to a large increase in the number of filers. The figures below reflect information about tax filing, but that does not necessarily reflect patterns of consumption for sugar-sweetened beverages.
