Questions and Answers for Specification No. 21-11450-C COMMUNITY PARTERNSHIPS IN COVID-19 RESPONSE

The City of Berkeley has received questions from potential respondents regarding **Specification No. 21-11450-C**, **COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS IN COVID-19 RESPONSE.** In an effort to provide the same information to all, listed below is the question received to date, with response from City staff.

- Q1: We have hosted vaccination and testing pop up clinics. Can that be one of our objectives?
- A1: Yes. Hosting vaccination and testing pop-up/mobile clinics to serve the target populations is one of the three (3) services sought in this RFP.
- Q2: If we want to partner with community groups that are not 501(c)(3) nonprofits to help with education and outreach activities, how do I account for that in the application?
- A2: If you wish to subcontract for some services, you can provide that in your budget as a separate line in the Personnel Expense section. Please label the expense as "Subcontract" and describe the service in your application.
- Q3: What is the range that we can apply for?
- A3: There is no minimum or maximum required amount that you may apply for.
