Questions and Answers for Specification No. 22-11469 Parts for Eight Police Utility Vehicles

The City of Berkeley has received questions from some potential respondents regarding **Specification No. 22-11469, Parts for Eight Police Utility Vehicles**. In an effort to provide the same information to all, listed below are the questions received to date, with responses from City staff.

1. Q. In the Whelen Section of the Excel Sheet, are you asking for

CENCOM CORE PN C399
Controller 7 PN CCTL7
OBD II PN C399K4

A. Yes, we want a CenCom core with a CCTL7 and an OBD II.

2. Q. Traffic Advisor Module PN CTA - If WCX bar to C399 external TA module isn't needed....are you running a TAM83 in the rear window?

A. Correct, we will not need the CTA with a WCX lightbar. We will be removing line 36 (CTA) from the list as we have no plans to run an extra TA.

3. Q. And do you need CANEM16 – expansion module?

A. Not at this time.
