

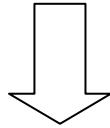

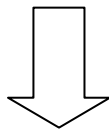

- Will prioritize needs based on the PEI State guidelines and requirements



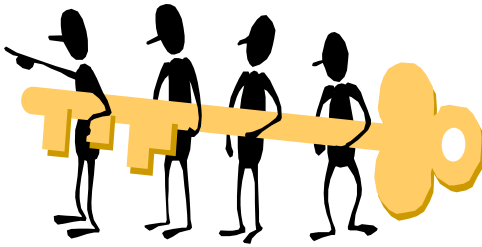
Plan Development, Review and Approval Process



- MHSA Steering Committee makes recommendations for final draft PEI plan
- Plan approved by Mental Health Manager
- 30 Day Public Comment Period and Public Hearing
- Finalized plan sent to State DMH and the Oversight and Accountability Commission
- OAC approves plans or requests further information
- When the plan is approved, programs can begin

Prevention and Early Intervention Guidelines--\$600,000 annually

Key Community Mental Health Needs

- Disparities in Access to Mental Health Services

- At Risk Children, Youth and Young Adult Populations
- Stigma & Discrimination
- Suicide Risk

Priority Populations

- Underserved Cultural Populations
- Individuals experiencing onset of serious psychiatric illness
- Children/Youth in stressed families
- Trauma-Exposed individuals
- Children/Youth at risk for school failure
- Children/Youth at risk of, or experiencing Juvenile Justice involvement

- Use evidence based program design (resources provided)
- Leveraging—value on utilizing other resources to expand strategies
- Must conduct a local outcome evaluation of one PEI Project
