

RESOLUTION NO 67,682-N S

CONTRACT FUNDING ALLOCATION OF \$125,000 TO LIFELONG MEDICAL CARE
TO MANAGE A MINI-GRANTS PROGRAM FOR FY17

WHEREAS, the consumption of Sugar-Sweetened Beverages (SSBs) in Berkeley is impacting the health of the people in Berkeley, and

WHEREAS, the City Council is committed to decreasing the consumption of SSBs and mitigating the harmful impacts of SSBs on the population of Berkeley, and

WHEREAS, on January 19, 2016, the City Council passed Resolution No 67,356-N S which included allocation of \$125,000 under Budget Code 010-4501-440-3038 for the Public Health Division to enter into a contract with a third party to establish a mini-grants program for FY17 designed to reduce consumption of SSBs and to address the effects of SSB consumption on health, and

WHEREAS, a Request for Proposal (RFP) Specification No 16-11019-C was released on February 16, 2016, and no proposals were received, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Public Health Division that a contract with Lifelong Medical Care, an existing contractor and collaborator with the City of Berkeley, is the best way to effectuate this mini-grants program, and

WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$125,000 have been budgeted in budget code 010-4501-440-3038 to cover the expenses of the mini-grants program, including conducting the RFP process, monitoring the mini-grant contracts, and participating in program development and evaluation, and

WHEREAS, the contract has been entered into the City contract database and assigned a CMS No KT83F

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Berkeley that the City Manager is authorized to execute a contract and any amendments or extensions thereto, with Lifelong Medical Care, in an amount not to exceed \$125,000 for the period of October 1, 2016 to December 31, 2017 A records signature copy of the said agreement and any amendments to be on file in the Office of the City Clerk
