## PAYMENT PLAN (NEW)

We know that paying for your child's summer camp fees for the entire summer upfront can be challenging. This year, we are offering a payment plan option for families. Pay 50% of your camp fee at registration to hold your spot and then pay the other 50% by May 3, 2021 (for Echo Programs) or May 10, 2021 (for all other programs). ## SUMMER 2021 REFUND & CANCELLATION POLICY

---

All requests for refunds must be directed to:

Recreation & Youth Services Manager

The original receipt must be submitted with a written request for a refund. The request must state the reason for the refund, and the date, time and location of the program. The Recreation and Youth Services Manager will render a decision to either: 1) refund the fee; 2) pro-rate the fee; 3) apply the fees to another session or program; or 4) deny the request.

A. Recreation and Marina Program & Services: No refunds or credit will be granted without 7 days notice prior to start of class or date of reservation. The City will deduct an administrative fee of 25%, or a minimum of \$10 service charge (whichever is greater).

B. Camp Programs: No refunds will be provided if cancellation is made less than 30 days before camp arrival date. A refund will be provided if the entire reservation is cancelled not less than 30 calendar days prior to arrival date, less a 25% administration fee not to exceed \$150.

We may need to modify, cancel, or alter programs or individual registrations to comply with COVID-19 public health guidelines. If we need to modify programs impacting your registration, we will notify you with available options. If we are required to cancel registrations to comply with COVID-19 health orders or other related regulations, we will offer campers a 100% refund of all paid fees.

In the event that public health guidelines require a reduction in the maximum capacity of participants, we may charge an additional COVID-19 surcharge to cover unforeseen expenses.

- These surcharges are contingent upon City of Berkeley, El Dorado County, State, and Federal health codes that have yet to be released. If necessary, these surcharges will be developed and communicated to campers as soon as we receive information from the agencies above.

## BERKELEY FUN CAMPS

Calling all fun seekers! Enthusiastic and talented Recreation Division staff will guide groups through a fun and safe traditional summer camp experience. Each session will feature a thrilling new theme. Campers will have the opportunity to participate in a wide variety of sports & games, community building activities, arts & crafts, and other activities which will highlight the incredible park features at each site.

Campers and staff will remain in stable groups for the duration of each session (sessions will 3 weeks long). Campers must attend the program regularly to remain enrolled. Staff will adhere to a rigorous cleaning and disinfection routine and will run each site in accordance with social distancing requirements. Face coverings are required for all Staff and Campers. Staff and Campers will be required to complete a daily wellness check, including having their temperature taken at sign-in.

Each site will have a designated parent drop-off and pick-up location, and parents are responsible for providing their own transportation to and from program sites.

## BERKELEY DAY CAMP

Sessions will be three-weeks in length, and each week, group sites will rotate to one of these three parks. You can select your preferred rotation schedule and age range below. We will offer three (3) sessions of this program this summer. Additional information, including weekly program schedules and activities and other fun events will be released at a later date.

### CHANGES TO BERKELEY DAY CAMP

- This season **we are not providing bus stop transportation to or from Berkeley Day Camp program sites for Campers or Counselors In Training (CIT's).**
- Each week Berkeley Day Camp pods will rotate to one of the three parks listed above, and parents will be responsible for dropping off their camper at the park location their group is scheduled to attend that day.

#### **Additional Notes:**

- Fees are all-inclusive for each session, for up to 3 total guests, and include meals, lodging, and all programs. We cannot prorate session fees.
- Additional Campers may be added to Standard Occupancy tent cabin registrations for a fee of \$375 per person, per session. This fee does not apply to infants (under age 3). Maximum of 8 guests per tent, please.
- A limited number of low-occupancy tents are available to groups comprised of one adult and two children under the age of 14 only. These tents are available on a first come first served basis. Guests with different group sizes or age ranges must register for one of our Standard Occupancy Tent Cabins.

### CHANGES TO THE FAMILY CAMP PROGRAM

- This season we will use an online registration system for our Family Camp registrations.
- This season we will utilize session based fees instead of quarter day fees.
  - We are offering two 7-day sessions and one 5-day session.
  - Participation fees are per tent, not per individual camper.
- Generally, all families will arrive on the first day of each Family Camp session and depart on the last day of each session.
  - Families may be able to arrive or depart on alternate dates, however, we are unable to prorate fees for these sessions.
  - At check-in a lottery draw will determine order of tent selection.
