

RESOLUTION NO. 68,117-N.S.

CONTRACT: FIELDTURF USA, INC. FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF ARTIFICIAL
TURF AT TOM BATES REGIONAL SPORTS COMPLEX

WHEREAS, the existing artificial turf fields at Tom Bates Regional Sports Complex is in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, the City has neither the labor nor the equipment necessary to undertake this project; and

WHEREAS, Charter section 67.2 allows the City to purchase goods without undergoing a competitive bid process if the City is using pricing obtained by another public entity through a competitive process; and

WHEREAS, the California Multiple Award Schedule is available to state and local governments; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of General Service Procurement Division determined FieldTurf USA, Inc.'s bid pricing to be fair and reasonable and awarded CMAS Contract No. 4-06-78-0031A; and

WHEREAS, FieldTurf USA, Inc. was determined to be the most responsive and responsible proposal that met the selection criterion for the project; and

WHEREAS, funding is available in the FY 2018 budget in the Gilman Fields Capital Reserve AC (Fund 112).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Berkeley authorizes the City Manager to execute a contract and any amendments, extensions, or change orders until completion of the project in accordance with the terms and conditions of the agreement with FieldTurf USA, Inc. for the artificial turf replacement project at Tom Bates Regional Sports Complex, in an amount not to exceed \$1,418,629, which includes a 10% contingency. A record signature copy of the agreement and any amendments to be on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Berkeley Park, Recreation and Waterfront and General Services reviewed the CMAS Contract and determined the contract meet the needs of the project.

The foregoing Resolution was adopted by the Berkeley City Council on July 25, 2017 by the following vote:


