PROJECT DESCRIPTION

On June 27, 2017, Council approved a **Citywide Restroom Needs Assessment Project** for Phase 1 of the Measure T1 bond program. This project will include the evaluation of existing public restrooms, a community input process, and the research of ecologically friendly restrooms with the goal of providing recommended locations and types and conceptual designs for upgrades of existing and new public restroom solutions in Berkeley.
