In 2019, the City of Berkeley and San Francisco Bay Ferry (WETA) partnered to study a potential dual-purpose pier for public recreation and commuter ferry operations at the Berkeley Municipal Pier.

On January 21, 2021, the City hosted the Community Workshop #1 to seek public feedback on a variety of project components such as the community's use and travel patterns at the Marina. 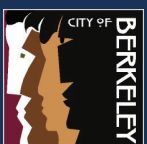
