*P3a Description: (Describe resource and its major elements. Include design, materials, condition, alterations, size, setting, and boundaries)

The Acheson Physicians' Building is a four-story commercial storefront building with one-story addition near the entry to the University of California campus. Constructed in 1908, it was designed by architect George I. Mohr. The 1925 addition was designed by architect James W. Plachek. It was recorded and reevaluated by LSA Associates, Inc. in May 2012 as a part of the Acheson Commons Project. That attached report comprises the technical information for this current recording.

B10. Significance:

The 1908 Acheson Physicians' Building is a City of Berkeley Landmark designated on January 7, 1983 based on an application prepared by Anthony B. Bruce. The property was initially surveyed in 1978 as a part of the Berkeley Urban Conservation Survey and found eligible for the National Register by OHP. The property was reevaluated as a part of the Acheson Commons Project EIR by Michael Hibma, M.A. of LSA Associates, Inc. who found that the property was still eligible for the National Register.

The building is a Contributor to the Shattuck Avenue Downtown Historic District.
