Hi Loyal,

I just received a call from Steven LaMond and wanted to document it with you. He was calling to voice his concerns with the project, primarily regarding parking congestion. He also submitted the same concerns in emails dated 9/8/18 and 9/24/28. His concerns center around the potential for overflow parking from area residents and businesses onto the surrounding city streets, specifically relate to the MOB that may get more patients driving to the site than anticipated. He is suggesting the creation of on-street, resident-only parking spaces and/or shared parking or possibly a dedicated parking space at the Pardee Lot for the residents of his building. He also wanted to confirm that we had received his letters and that they would be responded to.

I told him that yes, we had received both the original letter and the follow up letter, and that we would be formally responding to his concerns in the RTC/Final MND. He was also told that he will be receiving an official, albeit general, response letter from the city and that he would be invited to attend the ZAB hearing on the 25th of this month.
