Berkeley Police Make Arrest in Jermaine Davis Homicide

Berkeley, California (Tuesday, January 7, 2014) – The City of Berkeley Police Department (BPD) would like to announce an arrest for the July 17, 2013 murder of Jermaine Davis. Antiown Ramon York, 25 years old, of Pittsburg, was arrested and booked into the Berkeley City Jail on January 6, 2014 for murder, PC 187.

On Wednesday, July 17, 2013 at approximately 6:52 p.m., BPD patrol officers responded to multiple reports of shots fired, with a victim down in the 1800 block of Derby Street. BPD officers arrived on scene and discovered a single male victim down, suffering from gunshot wounds. The victim was transported to a local hospital by the Berkeley Fire Department. The victim was pronounced deceased at the hospital. The victim was identified as Jermaine Chapman Davis, 26 years old, of Berkeley.

Detectives have been gathering evidence and pursuing leads in relation to Davis' murder. Based on the investigation, the District Attorney's Office charged Antiown York with murder, and a court-filed arrest warrant was issued.

On Monday, January 6, working with members of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and the support of the Daly City Police Department, BPD Detectives and BPD Special Response Team members located York in Daly City and placed him under arrest. The arrest was made without incident or injury, and York was booked into the Berkeley City Jail

In the interest of maintaining the integrity of this investigation, BPD has no further information to share at this time.
