Berkeley, California (DATE) - The City of Berkeley is offering a \$15,000 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s) responsible for a homicide that occurred on December 4, 2012 in the 2700 block of Sacramento Street.

On Tuesday, December 4, 2012 at about 11:36 p.m., the Berkeley Police Department responded to the 2700 block of Sacramento Street, and found Pamula Mullins, 50, of Berkeley, deceased from a gunshot wound.
