Attention Property Owners and Managers:

If you own or manage property in the City of Berkeley and are experiencing problems with drug dealing, trespassers, vagrants, solicitors, illegal dumping, or unauthorized people standing on your property, you may take the following actions:

1. Post **"NO TRESPASSING/PRIVATE PROPERTY"** signs on your property.
2. Complete and return a "No Trespassing" letter to the Chief of Police. This letter will be kept on file in the Police Department's Patrol Division. Subsequently, all police patrol units will be notified that this letter is on file.

Please call the Berkeley Police Department at 981-5900 for non-emergencies, or 911 for emergencies when trespassers are on your property, and the trespasser(s) will be removed or arrested.
